Generous and soft with full, ripe tropical flavors. Beautifully structured with a long finish.

Chardonnay, Rodney Strong, Sonoma Valley

Bright lemon and apple aromas with hints of toasty barrel complexity, and on the palate, pear and pineapple with spice and refreshing acidity.

Chardonnay, Kendall-Jackson "Vintners Reserve", California

Tropical flavors dance with aromas of peach, apple and pear. Richly layered and balanced throughout with a lingering finish.

Sauvignon Blanc, Ch. Ste. Michelle, Columbia Valley

A crisp, clean, refreshing style with fresh aromas and flavors of lemongrass, apple and melon.

Pinot Grigio, Voga, Veneto, Italy

\$26.

Soft alluring flavors, full and rich, with fresh, ripe apple and pear aromas and delicious, juicy flavors.

Riesling, Relax, Mosel, Germany

Intense flavors of apples and peaches with just a hint of citrus. The natural acidity gives this wine a perfect balance that is refreshingly crisp.

White Zinfandel, Beringer, California

Fresh red berry, citrus and melon aromas and flavors with subtle hints of nutmeg and clove.

Sparkling Wines

Riviera Champagne, New York State

\$5.

A pale, straw-colored champagne that has a crisp flavor with a hint of fruit. The cuvee is a blend of Aurore, Delaware, Chardonnay and Catawba.

Martini & Rossi, Asti Spumante, Italy

\$28.

Tangerine, honeysuckle, vanilla, butter and honeyed notes. Very clean and zesty with refreshing acidity.

Moet & Chandon, "White Star", Champagne, France

\$70.

A balanced blend revealing a harmonious succession of sensations, a soft maturity, and elegant lines. Soft and mature aroma and hints of nuts.

Red Wines

Cabernet Sauvignon, Angeline, Sonoma Valley

\$32.

A fruit-forward, easy to drink style. The rich black cherry and plum flavors are layered with hints of vanilla and creamy oak that linger on the palate.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Rodney Strong, Sonoma

\$8. \$35.

Aromas of blackberry, cocoa, and cedar lead to a rich, layered mouthfeel with black cherry, vanilla and cassis and lush, mature tannins.

Cabernet Sauvignon, J. Garcia, Sonoma County

\$39.

Blackberry, black currant, vanilla and spice aromas with ripe berry flavors and a soft finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon, J. Lohr "Seven Oaks", Paso Robles

\$42.

Dark cherry, black currant and berry fruit aromas and flavors with spicy cedar, vanilla and toasty notes and a lingering intensity.

Merlot, Blackstone, California

\$22.

Rich fruit aromas, supple oak characters and soft tannins. Ripe and soft in the mouth, with bright cherry fruit flavors and a soft, lingering finish.

Merlot, Ch. Ste. Michelle, Columbia Valley

\$8. \$36.

Complex yet approachable with aromas and flavors of black cherry, cola, leather and spice. Soft and accessible with layers of complexity.

Merlot, Casa Lapostolle "Cuvee Alexandre", Chile

\$42.

Aromas of plums and black currant with notes of rosemary, white pepper and basil. Round and creamy with elegant oak and fresh acidity.

Zinfandel, Rodney Strong, Sonoma Valley

\$8. \$24.

Fresh berry fruit with ripe peppery jamminess makes for wonderful diversity of flavor showcasing the best that zinfandel can offer in one wine.

Zinfandel, Murphy Goode, "Liar's Dice", Sonoma

\$44.

Rich, dark fruit characteristics, flavors of black raspberry and blackberry jam and soft tannins that perfectly balance the sweetness of the fruit.

Pinot Noir, Robert Mondavi Private Selection, California

Raspberry and dried cherry aromas mingle with white and black pepper, mint and chicory. Medium-bodied with berry and cherry flavors.

Shiraz, Greg Norman, Limestone Coast, Australia

\$38.

Aromas of ripe plum, blackberry, vanilla and spice with light subtle hints of blueberry and blackcurrant fruit. Full flavored and balanced.

Cabernet-Shiraz, Penfolds, "Bin 389", Australia

\$45.

Plum flavors with notes of cinnamon, nutmeg and peppercorns. Full-bodied, persistent and long.

Reserve Blend, Duckhorn, "Paraduxx", Napa
